I. INTENT

The maximum fare rates chargeable to passengers by taxis having Village medallions have not been increased in more than a decade. During this period, there has been a substantial increase in the operating costs of taxi owners, including but not limited to vehicle costs, insurance premiums and fuel expenses. In order to insure that operation of these taxis is sufficiently viable economically so that there will be an adequate number of operating taxis to serve the needs of Village residents and businesses, the Village Board of Trustees hereby finds that it will serve the health, benefit and welfare of the Village and its residents to adopt the following rate increases over a period of four years.

II. AMENDMENTS

1. Section 193-14(B) of the Village Code is hereby amended to state as follows:

“B. The maximum fare, by zones, for persons other than senior citizens, shall be as follows:

(1) Effective February 1, 2022:

----Zone 1 (without crossing into any other zone)	\$3.75

----Zone 3	\$5.50
----Zone 4	\$6.00
----Zone 5	\$6.50

(2) Effective February 1, 2024:

----Zone 1 (without crossing into any other zone)	\$4.50

----Zone 7	\$9.25
----Zone 8	\$10.50

2. Section 193-14(C)(1) is hereby amended to state as follows:

“(C)(1) The maximum fare rate for senior citizens holding any senior citizen identification card will be fifty cents (\$0.50) less than each of the rates set forth above.”

(2) SEVERABILITY

The invalidity of any section or provision of this Local Law shall not affect any other provision or portion of this Local Law which can be given effect without such provision.

(3) EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective immediately as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law upon being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
